## GDPR – Privacy Legislation

In view of the new GDPR legislation regarding data protection, we hereby request your permission for a number of processing operations during which our dance school uses personal data.

The school requests the following information from students:

- Surname, first name, date of birth, telephone number and e-mail address.

Used for internal communication to parents and pupils (brochure, announcement of workshops or exams, adjustments to the timetable, extra training courses, notification in the case of a teacher's absence, etc.).

Exchange of personal data with third parties: when participating in examinations, there is an exchange with the ISTD (Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing) board in London.

- Medical data for first aid workers in case of accident or risk situations

We ask for medical data that may be of importance when teaching. The dance school will only process this information with the intention of being able to respond adequately in the case of a risk or an accident. You are not obliged to provide information about the health of yourself or your child, however, the dance studio cannot take into account any uncommunicated medical information.

Personal data is kept only for the duration of the student's membership, and is then deleted from the school's database.

Photo-/ video- and audio recording of activities related to our dance studio may be published for internal communication (information brochure) and external communication (leaflets, flyers, dance studio website and social media of the dance studio) without compensation. YES  NO
